Dear Parents/Guardians,

Our topic this term is Anglo-Saxons and Vikings. Therefore to immerse the children in the topic we have arranged a trip for the year 5 to visit the Yorkshire museum for an Anglo-Saxon workshop and a guided tour around York Minster. York is one of the oldest medieval cities and has a rich history associated with the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings.

The workshop will explore life in Anglo Saxon York in the 11th Century. Pupils will handle museum artefacts and take part in activities to find out about home life, work and religion. The tour of York Minster will allow the children to find out about the hidden treasures in this amazing historic church.

We will be visiting York on Friday 9th February and after a generous contribution from the school, the cost of the trip will be £12.

The coach will leave school at 8am so we are asking the children to be at school for 7.45am. If your child has a packed lunch please can they bring it with them in a disposable carrier bag. If your child has school dinners, lunch will be provided for them unless they wish to bring their own. If your child suffers from travel sickness please administer any medicines before school and give any medication to be taken on the return journey to the teachers clearly labelled with the child's name and instructions in an envelope. There may be an opportunity to visit the gift shop at the Yorkshire museum so your child can bring a maximum of £5 to spend, again can this be in an envelope and clearly labelled with the child's name.
