NEU Strike Action Notice

You may be aware from media coverage that the NEU (National Education Union) has declared strike action, which will take place on the following dates:

- Wednesday, 1 February
- Tuesday, 28 February
- Wednesday, 15 March
- Thursday, 16 March

The strike is happening because of a national dispute between the unions and the government over pay. We are in the process of assessing how the planned strike action may impact our staffing levels. Every effort will be made to ensure that St. Kentigern's remains open on the above dates; any changes will be clearly communicated in due course.




Year 6 enjoyed solving problems using their knowledge on finding the area of triangles and parallelograms.

Acorns Closure

As you are aware, our school has the facility of an aged 2 Acorns provision. Changes in how families now manage their childcare, together with a range of other contributing factors, has meant that it has proven difficult to sustain this offer. The Governors and I have looked at all possible scenarios and unfortunately the decision has been made to close the Acorns. Therefore, we are giving notice that the Acorns will not reopen when school returns on the 27^{th} February. Our Nursery provision will continue in the usual manner and will not be affected by the closure of the Acorns.

I understand that this decision is disappointing for the families who access the Acorns but this action has not been taken lightly. The provision will continue to run in the usual manner until we break for half term on Friday 17^{th} February.
